


In this chapter we will explore several variations in the seating department and upgrade the floorboards for a more custom appearance. The changes you'll see here are fairly easy, but will radically alter the way your Yamaha feels after many hours of touring. Before making a decision, ask around and see what friends have to say about the seats they bought. Their opinion may not match your needs, but at least you can learn a bit more about the options in the market. J&P stocks a large selection of saddles and will be a great place to do your one stop shopping.

With Kody seated on the stock seat with factory bars, we see the relation between his hands and looms and can compare this to the seat options soon to be seen.



One first seat option comes from Saddlemen (J&P Part # ZZ80087), and is called the Saddletyle. Beneath the upholstered surface is a gel that adds comfort while bringing a new level of style to the game.



A second choice will be from Mustang (J&P Part # ZZ80136), and is a more traditional saddle that includes a backrest for added rider comfort.



With the main section set aside, slide the passenger pillion forward to remove it from the Road Star.



Using a 10mm Allen wrench, loosen and remove the fastener that holds the passenger seat in place.



The factory mounting bracket will also need to be removed prior to installing the Saddlemen seat.



Turning the ignition key allows you to lift the front portion of the Yamaha seat free of its mounts.



The front hoop brackets on the Yamaha seat will need to be transferred to the Saddlemen seat, use the same mounting bolts to attach to the new saddle.

The book is a very simple read, is easy to follow and features plenty of photos.
