# BIKE PROTECTION

## Exigent has got ya covered

WHETHER YOU RIDE A STOCK HARLEY OR A custom chopper like the fully covered one below, protecting its finishes is a prime concern 365 days a year. For most of my bikes, a standard-size cover will do the deed. However, last year, I picked up a 10'-long chopper and then realized



that the same ol', same ol' was not going to work. And since I've got three kids running in and out of my garage, a bike cover is not optional equipment. To that end, I called the guys at Exigent Bike Covers and told them I needed protection. Since the bike is always kept in the garage when not in use, Exigent suggested that I use its Long Bike dust cover (\$59),

which is good for bikes up to 10'4" long. This cover is perfect for indoor storage — Since it's made of breathable nylon, it doesn't trap moisture on the bike and cause rust. In fact, this cover is so soft, you'd think it was made by Victoria's Secret. But it's not heat resistant, so don't put it on until your bike has fully cooled. As for installation, it literally takes one minute, thanks to the loose elastic bottom.

Of course, Exigent also makes a full line of rain covers, but that's another story. AIM
