# GATORHIDE

It's a wrap!

THE PLAN WAS TO TOW OUR ALMOST-NEW AND much-loved Electra Glide behind our motor home on a trip from our home in Vermont to central Texas. Have you ever been in a rainstorm behind a motor home? If so, you know how much grime and

road grit gets kicked up and thrown onto whatever is behind you. Since we didn't want our bike to get trashed during the trip, we did some research and bought a GatorHide motorcycle cover. This all-encasing cover kept our little monster clean and safe from punishing rocks, debris, and all of the other little surprises the elements had in store. In fact, the bike was just as

clean as when we wrapped it up.

GatorHides are available in three different styles, so they can gently hug your sportbike, cruiser, or touring model in an inner layer of cushiony fleece. On the outside is an outer wrapping of super-tough



ballistic nylon and neoprene. As you can see, the outer cover completely wraps around and under the bike. Accessories like saddlebags, sissy bars, and floorboards are not a problem because these covers are designed to allow for them, since the fit is adjustable.

Installation is pretty straightforward with easy-to-read instructions. (Just make sure the engine is cool, and the bike is clean to avoid any scratches.) And though the initial installation takes a little time, once you have it all adjusted GatorHide covers are designed to be taken on and off in minutes, not counting tie-down time. AIM
