# ICON'S DAYTONA JACKET

## Why it's good to be stealthy



THERE'S SOMETHING TO BE SAID FOR A properly fitted leather jacket that you can wear all year round, but when I heard this baby had a Stealth option, I had to get one. I figured I could outrun cops, blow off tolls, and split lanes, while no one would be the wiser until I was safely at home kicking back and enjoying a frosty beverage. Then I realized that Stealth was a color option, not a groundbreaking material that renders you invisible to radar and the naked eye. Oh, well, I ordered it anyway.

The Daytona has a lot of cool features, aside from the not-so-ground-breaking Stealth option. For starters, the leather is thick and durable, and cut to fit snugly on the trunk of your body, with the sleeves left a little long for that reach to the bars. It has a removable liner for brisk weather, and vents on the shoulders and lower back to keep you cool on hot summer days. The CE-approved armor keeps you covered on the back, elbows, forearms, and shoulders. And, for those who find the fit too tight, side expansion vents can be opened to deliver a few more inches of breathing room. The jacket is available in seven different color options that you can check out online. All told, the Daytona Jacket is very comfortable and reasonably priced at \$350.

Embossed on a large leather flap inside the Daytona, an Icon slogan reads "Ride Among Us." At the moment, I'm doing my best to live up to those noble words, but you may not see me because I'm wearing my Stealth
