MOTOREX HELMET CARE

If you wear a helmet, you need this stuff

LET'S FACE FACTS: IF YOU WEAR A HELMET on a regular basis, it gets funky, and nobody I know wants to be in a funk. So to keep that funk off my head, I use a spray called Helmet Care from Motorex, which is just a can filled with cleaning foam that's designed to clean, deodorize, and protect not only the inside of the helmet, but the shell, too.

Use this stuff on the outside of a brain bucket and it will brighten up the colors, remove anything stuck to the shell (like bugs and road grime), and protect the paint and finish. For the inside, where things can get real ugly, the foam's enzyme formula supposedly eats any bacteria, which is probably causing the odors. (BTW, using a product designed to attack bacteria is the only real way to clean anything that is fabric and has absorbed sweat.) An added plus is that Helmet Care leaves behind a pleasant, fresh aroma. Trust me when I say my skull appreciates it when I use this stuff,



and yours will, too. The beauty here is that, after using Helmet Care, my helmet not only smells good, but it has actually been cleaned, which translates into lasting freshness.

I try to use Helmet Care on all of my lids at the beginning and end of the riding season here in the Northeast. I've found that the 200mL aerosol can easily cleans all of my helmets, which is a deal, considering it has a suggested retail price of \$5.95. With the amount of time that I

make my head spend in a helmet, it's about time I started doing something nice for what is probably the most important part of my body. AIM
