1	Left Rear Axle Slider (clutch side)	1	M8 x 1.25 x 75mm Threaded Rod
1	Right Rear Axle Slider (brake side)	1	M8 Coupling Nut
1	Rear Axle Sliders Final Drive (clutch side)	2	M8 x 1.25 Jam Nuts
1	M8 Flat Washer	1	M8 x 1.25 x 60mm Button Head Cap Screw

Metric hex bit set, combination wrench set, flat edge tool, blue loctite

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.

STEP 2 Refer to PIC 2 and 3. Start on the clutch rear side of the motorcycle. With a flat edge tool, gently pry the cover off from around the rear axle.

STEP 3 Locate provided Right Rear Axle Slider (brake side), Threaded Rod, Coupling Nut, and two (2) Jam Nuts.

STEP 4 Refer to PIC 4. Thread a jam nut on to either end of the threaded rod, allowing for enough space to thread the coupling nut on one end and the axle slider on the other end. Fasten the axle slider to the threaded rod, and the coupling nut onto the other end.



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STEP 5 Refer to PIC 5 and 6. From the brake side of the motorcycle, remove the cap covering the axle area.

STEP 6 Refer to PIC 6. Insert the threaded rod assembly, attached to the rear axle slider right, through the brake side axle area.

STEP 7 Locate provided left rear axle slider, flat washer and the button head cap screw. Apply a small amount of blue loctite to the threads of the screw. Place the washer on the screw.

STEP 8 Refer to PIC 7 and 8. Align the slider over the axle area and fasten it to the couple nut on the threaded rod by using the button head cap screw. Adjustments may be needed to be made to the coupling nut and threaded rod to allow for the button screw to fasten. Remove the assembly and make adjustments as needed.

STEP 9 Once final adjustments have been made to the coupling nut and threaded rod, fully tighten the jam nuts on the threaded rod.

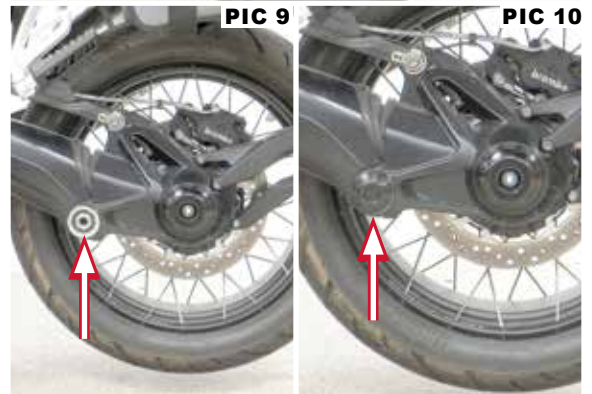
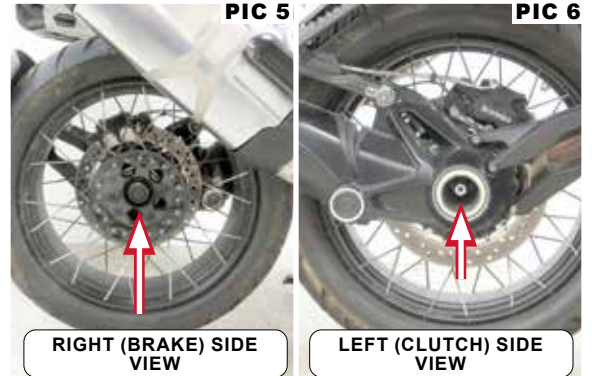
STEP 10 Refer to PIC 7. Realign and fasten the left axle slider and button head cap screw. Fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 11 Refer to PIC 9. On the clutch side of the motorcycle, use a flat edge tool to gently pry the cover off from the final drive.

STEP 12 Refer to PIC 10. Locate provided Rear Axle Slider Final Driver. Insert the slider into the open area of the final drive. Rotate while applying pressure to the axle slider to properly seat it.

Kuryakyn warrants that any Kuryakyn products sold hereunder, shall be free of defects in materials & workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the date of purchase by the consumer excepting the following provisions:

1. Kuryakyn shall have no obligation in the event the customer is unable to provide a receipt showing the date the customer purchased the product(s).
2. The product must be properly installed, maintained & operated under normal conditions.
3. Kuryakyn shall not be liable for any consequential & incidental damages, including labor & paint, resulting from failure of a Kuryakyn product, failure to deliver, delay in delivery, delivery in nonconforming condition, or for any breach of contract or duty between Kuryakyn & a customer.
4. Kuryakyn products are often intended for use in specific applications. Kuryakyn makes no warranty if a Kuryakyn product is used in applications other than intended.
5. Kuryakyn electrical products are warranted for one (1) year from the date of purchase by the consumer. L.E.D.'s contained in components of Kuryakyn products will be warranted for defects in materials & workmanship for 3 years from the date of purchase whereas all other components shall be warranted for one (1) year.
6. All warranty claims must be directed to the place of purchase. Merchandise sold through internet auction sites or any other unauthorized reseller shall not carry a Kuryakyn warranty. If unsure, please contact the place of purchase to verify they are an authorized Kuryakyn reseller.

RETURN POLICY

Merchandise determined to be defective may be returned up to one year from the date of purchase. Returns must be processed through original seller. Returned merchandise for any other reason other than warranty claims must be in like new condition & subject to a 20% restocking fee. All returns are subject to inspection for determination of full or partial credit. Any returned part that shows evidence of being used or installed contrary to manufacturer's instructions, &/or subjected to improper handling, packaging or return shipping by the customer, will not be eligible for exchange, refund or warranty consideration. All returned electrical items will be inspected & tested. If electrical item is deemed functional, no credit will be issued & item will be returned. All sales are final on discontinued or closeout merchandise.

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
