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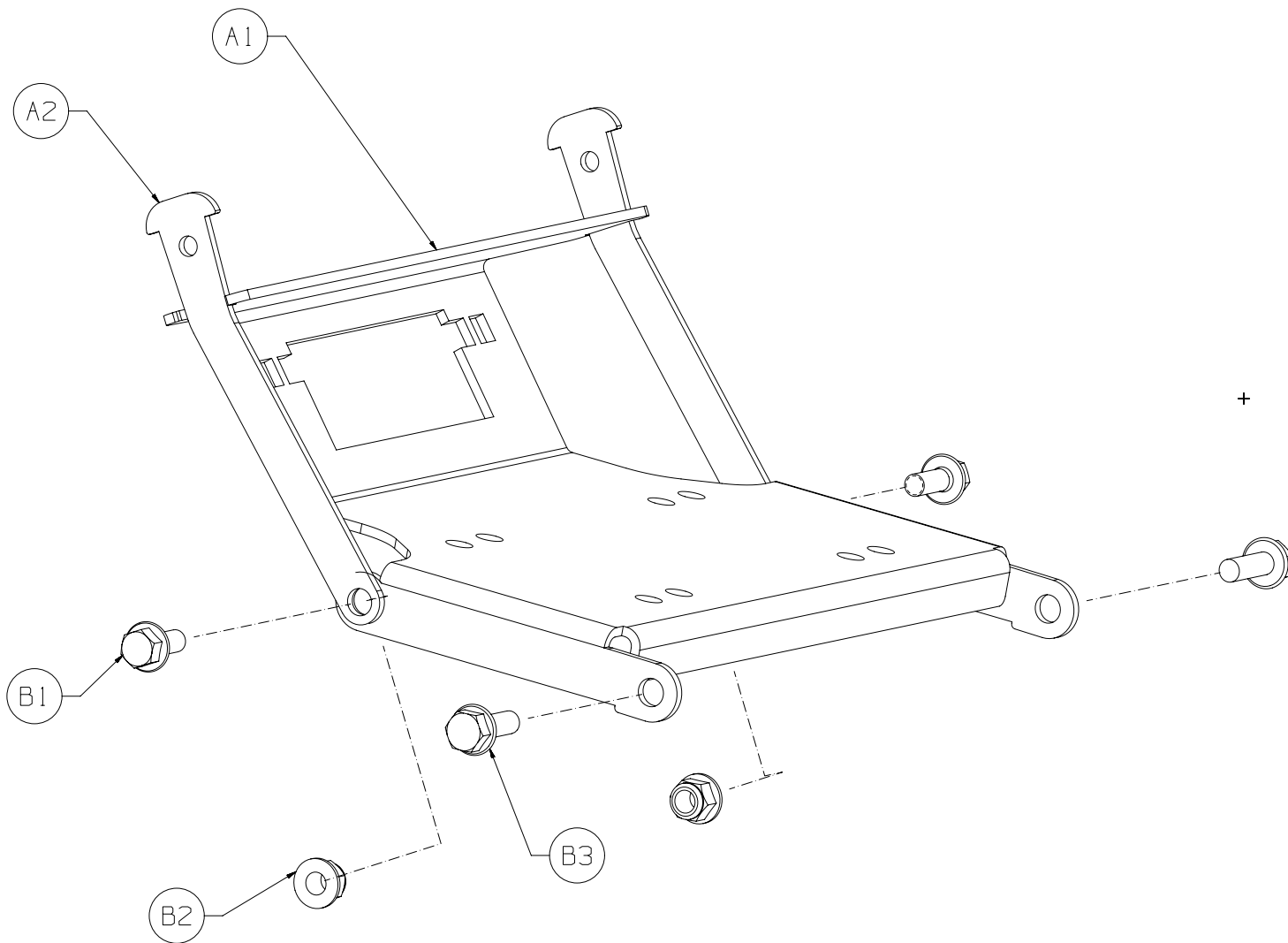

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the bumper by removing the two torx head screws, two upper M8 hardware and one lower M8 hardware from each side of vehicle.
2. Slide bumper forward while carefully leveraging the plastic out of the way.

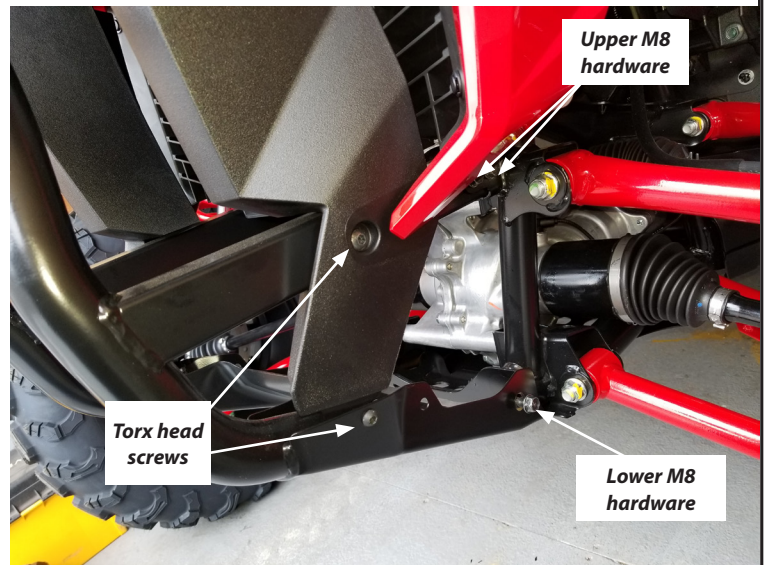

3. Install the fairlead to the winch mounting plate (A1) with hardware from your winch kit.
4. Place your winch upside down (feet facing up).
5. Set winch mounting plate on winch, lining up holes with winch feet.
6. Secure winch mounting plate to the winch using the winch install instructions and mounting hardware supplied in your winch kit.

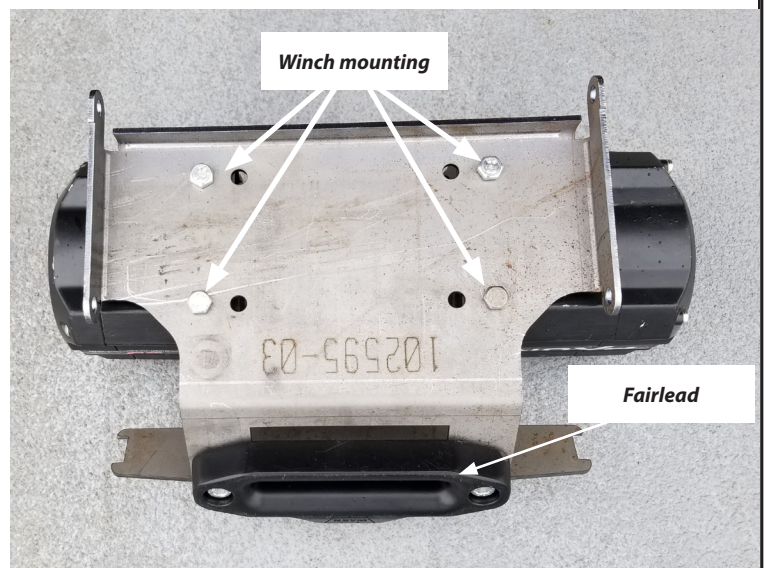

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Slide the winch mount assembly onto the bumper, aligning the front two holes of the mounting plate with the holes in the bumper.

TIP: It may be easier to attach winch cables to winch before proceeding.

- Install the flanged end of a winch mounting strap (A2) through the tab on the bumper.
- Align the other end of the winch mounting strap to the front holes on the winch mount and secure using the M8 x 20 bolt (B1) and lock nut (B2).
- Repeat steps 8 and 9 for other side.

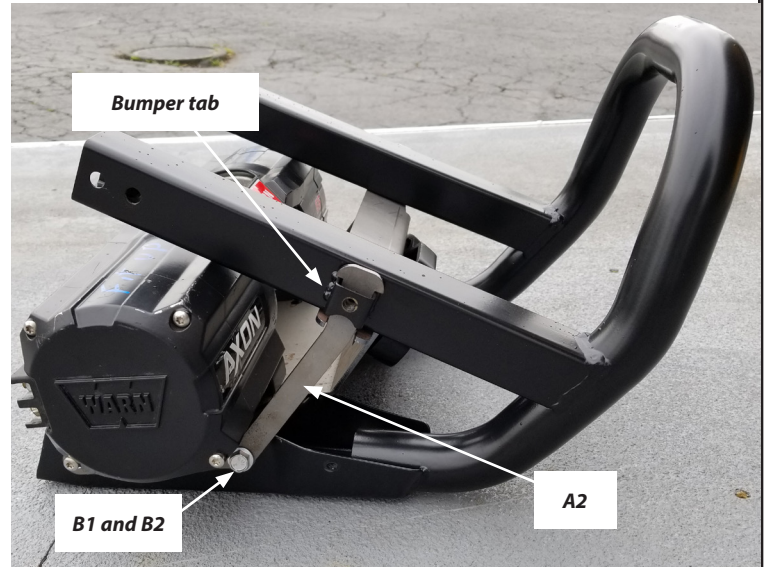

- With assistance, slide the bumper/winch assembly back over the frame, while leveraging the plastic back into position.
- Reinstall the two factory torx head screws through vehicle plastic, upper winch mounting strap and bumper tab hole.
- Install the two upper factory hardware to original position.
- Secure the rear portion of winch mounting plate using the longer M8 x 25 bolt (B3).
- Repeat steps 12-14 for other side.

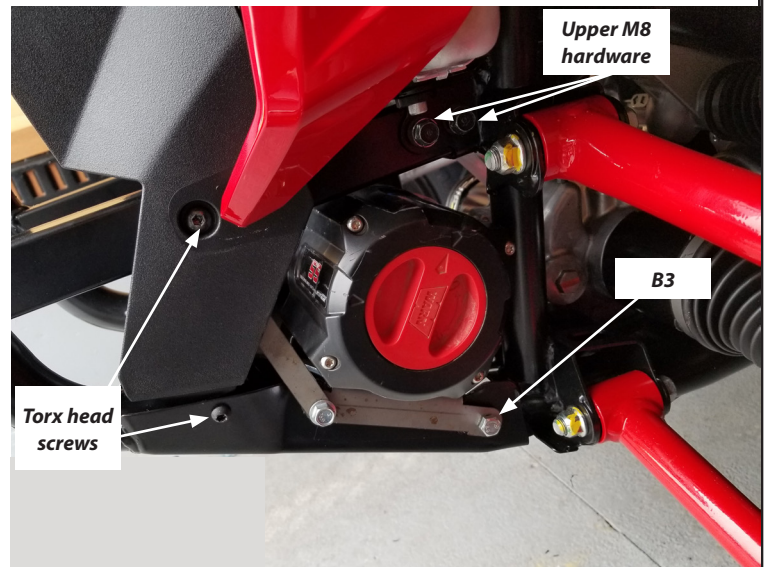

- Tighten all hardware now to torque specifications.
- Complete wiring the winch using your winch kit instructions.

MAINTENANCE / CARE

1. Inspect all parts on the winch, winch mount, and related hardware prior to each use. Replace all hardware that appears rusted or deformed.
2. Inspect all nuts and bolts on the winch, winch mount,, and related hardware prior to each use. Tighten all nuts that appear to be loose. Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced.
3. Check all cables prior to use. Replace cables that look worn or frayed.
4. Check all moving or rotating parts. Remove debris that may inhibit the part from moving freely.
