Installation steps:

- 1. Determine the mounting location. Usually the frame is a good choice. Make sure its an area that can not easily be hit if the bike falls over, and keep away from the engine and exhaust.
- 2. Clean the surface area where you wish to mount the hour meter. We recommend using brake cleaner and then isopropyl alcohol to remove any surface residue.
- 3. Use the adhesive strip on the back of the hour meter to place the hour meter in the desired location. (zip ties not included)
- 4. You can secure the hour meter with zip ties and routing them through the holes on the hour meter.
- 5. Start the engine to check that the hour meter is working. The display will turn on showing the working hours and the blinking dot. It will read 0.1 for every 6 minutes the bike is running.

Sensitivity Setting:

- 1. Press S and the display will show 'tot' for a few seconds. The display with then show the total recorded hours for about 8 seconds. While the total hours is showing, press S to show "PAr", press S again to enter the sensitivity settings.
- 2. <u>To Set Sensitivity:</u> If display shows HI, press S to change it to LO. Display will switch off after a few seconds. This means the sensitivity is set. If the sensitivity shows LO, press S to change it to H I.

Partial Counter:

- 1. Press S, the display with show "tot" and then total hours. While showing total hours, press S again to show "PAr". After a few seconds, it will show the partial recorded time that you can use for service intervals.
- 2. <u>To Reset:</u> While showing the partial recorded time, hold S until the display blinks "----". This means the partial counter is reset to zero.

Lock Mode:

1. Press S to show "tot". While the display is flashing "tot", hold S for 8 seconds to enter Lock Mode (Loc). To exit lock mode, press S again.

FAQ:





- 1. You cannot change the battery in this unit. The battery will last approximately 5 years.
- 2. You cannot add or remove hours logged onto the meter.
- 3. The lock function can only be activated with the bike off.
